

Fabric Collage Postcard Workshop Materials List

Here is the list of supplies* needed for this class (if you want to bring your own kit):

- ☐ Peltex (below, right, by Pellon 71F Ultra Firm 1-sided fusible interfacing) for postcard, cut into 6" x 4" piece;
- ☐ Print postcard backing image (download pdf from my website at <https://karolinewallace.net/2017/04/05/fabric-collage-workshop/>) onto InkJet fabric sheets (below, middle), use Steam-a-Seam 2 (below, left) to make backing fusible;
- ☐ Fabric for the background (to cover 6" x 4"), prepared to be fusible;
- ☐ Fabric prepared to be fusible for the vase (at least 3" x 4", free scraps will be available);
- ☐ Various fabrics for the flowers and leaves, prepared to be fusible (free scraps will be available);
- ☐ One pair of good, sharp scissors;
- ☐ Sheets of light fusible web* (preferably a light Steam-a-Seam or Pellon product);
- ☐ Inspiration: bring a picture from a magazine, from the art world, or your own photo;
- ☐ Postcard backings will be provided, or you can frame your work in a shadow box.*



**All necessary supplies can be purchased at class. Fusible web kits will be available at \$3, fusible-web prepared fabric kits will be available for \$10, and some 8" x 10" shadow box frames will be available for \$10.*
